### **FISHING LICENSE**

**For ages 15 and older a Conservation License and a Montana Fishing License are required.**

**Ages 1 - 14 do not require a license if accompanied by an adult who holds a valid Montana Fishing license. The combined daily and possession limit for the two (or more) anglers cannot exceed the legal limit for one licensed angler. To catch his or her legal limit, the youth must purchase a fishing license.**
